

Terms and Conditions

Riparian fencing:

- For the exclusion of livestock from waterways. It does not cover perimeter fencing. Riparian fencing must be a minimum distance of 30 feet back from the waterway.
- Cost-share will be 75% SRRCD, 25% landowner with a maximum SRRCD contribution of \$4000.00.

Exclusion fencing:

- For the exclusion of livestock from dugouts. It does not cover perimeter fencing.
- Cost-share will be 75% SRRCD, 25% landowner with a maximum SRRCD contribution of \$1000.00.

Livestock crossing:

- The creation of livestock crossing areas where livestock or small machinery may cross at a specified location in order to reduce stream-bank degradation and erosion on intermittent and smaller waterways.
- Cost-share will be 75% SRRCD, 25% landowner with a maximum SRRCD contribution of \$1000.00.

Alternative Riparian Watering (Waterway protection):

- For producers who have fenced off natural water courses, to purchase pumping equipment for watering livestock.
- Cost-share will be 75% SRRCD 25% landowner with a SRRCD maximum contribution of \$7500.00.

Alternative Riparian Watering (Groundwater protection):

- For producers who have fenced off dugouts, to purchase pumping equipment for watering livestock.
- Cost-share will be 50% SRRCD 50% Landowner with a SRRCD maximum contribution of \$5,000.00.

General Information:

The annual projects resulting from this program are subject to available annual funding. The SRRCD will determine application priorities in consultation with sub-district members and Board staff. All projects must be approved by the SRRCD Board prior to construction and/or installation.

The Landowner is to design the project in cooperation with the SRRCD staff and/or other partner organizations. The Landowner will perform necessary maintenance following the completion of the project and agrees to leave the project in place for a minimum of 10 years, and to not alter, change, remove or modify the project without the written consent of the SRRCD. After 10 years, all materials purchased and/or installed will become the property of the landowner.

I, _____ hereby authorize you, your engineers, agents, and/or employees with the necessary equipment, to enter upon the aforementioned land for the purpose of Riparian Management. I hereby declare that I have read and understand the Terms and Conditions of the Riparian Management program and agree to abide to the said Terms and Conditions if my application form is approved.

I agree to indemnify and save harmless the Seine-Rat River Conservation District from any and all claims and demands of every kind whatsoever for any loss, injury or damage arising as a result of the planning, construction or maintenance of the project on the above-mentioned land.
