- This program provides funding, for producers who have fenced off water courses/dugouts, to purchase pumping equipment for watering livestock. **Producers who have not yet fenced off the water course/dugout must simultaneously apply for our fencing program (see below).**
- The alternative watering for waterways program cost-share will be 75% SRRCD 25% landowner with a SRRCD maximum contribution of \$7500.00.
- The alternative watering for dugouts program cost-share will be 50% SRRCD 50% landowner with a SRRCD maximum contribution of \$5,000.00.

- The Waterway fencing program cost-share will be 75% SRRCD, 25% landowner with a maximum SRRCD contribution of \$4000.00.
- The Dugout fencing program cost-share will be 75% SRRCD, 25% landowner with a maximum SRRCD contribution of \$1000.00.
